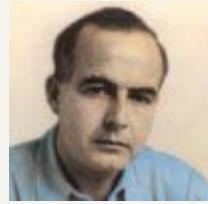

Symphony Orchestra to perform Barber piece at Orchestra Hall

Did you know what you wanted to do with your life when you were 9 years old?



Most of us didn't, but Samuel Barber did.

That's how old he was when he wrote this note:

"Dear Mother: I have written to tell you my worrying secret. Now don't cry when you read it because it is neither yours nor my fault. I suppose I will have to tell it now, without any nonsense. To begin with I was not meant to be an athlete. I was meant to be a composer, and will be I'm sure. I'll ask you one more thing. Don't ask me to try to forget this unpleasant thing and go play football, please. Sometimes I've been worrying about this so much that it makes me

mad (not very)."

He wrote his first operetta at age 10 and entered the Curtis Institute of Music at 14 where he excelled in piano, composition, and voice. Conducting? Yes, that, too. The overture to *The School for Scandal* was written when he was just 21 years old. **CYSO's Symphony Orchestra** will be performing this piece at **Orchestra Hall** on **Sunday, November 21 at 7:30 pm**.

They say youth is wasted on the young. Come find out why that wasn't true for Samuel Barber.
